...we are collecting for **5 Cents-A-Meal**.

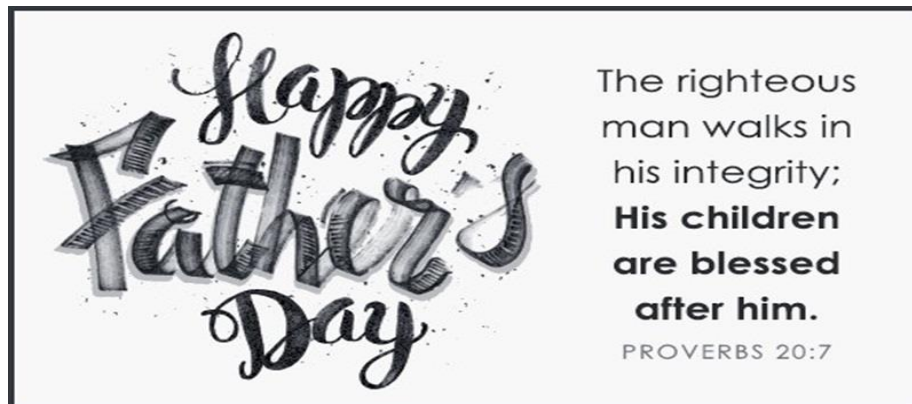
