Here we find that God never lost control of this world, but has given humans opportunity after opportunity to repent. The evil elements in culture see this as weakness, and so persecute the true worshippers of God. But God is coming, and will right the wrongs, by vindicating the worshippers and bringing judgment upon the oppressors. This section brings encouragement to a beaten-up people, that their sacrifices count to God...and so they are to remain faithful. God cares.
