- Session recommendation to Incorporate the Church

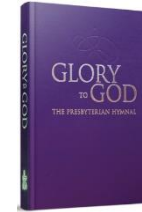

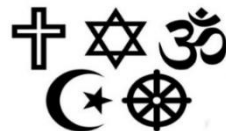
