Today's Call to Worship

In today's service, our *Call To Worship* addresses several women from the Bible. Here is a brief history of their 'acts of faith':

Rahab: hid the people sent by Joshua to spy out the land. Even when the city officials came with their demands, she refused to give them up.

Ruth: when her husband died, she didn't go back to her family of origin, but stayed with her mother-in-law...even following her back into Judea. She had no visible means of support, but went into the fields, all the while trusting God to provide.

Hannah: when she had no children, she promised that if she had a child, s/he would be dedicated to the Lord. When this child was born, she named him Samuel, and he became a great prophet.

Shiphrah and Puah: when Pharaoh declared that all male babies were to be killed, these midwives kept the child (who would become Moses) hidden...at risk to their own lives.
