### The Labyrinth is Coming! April 2<sup>nd</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> (Easter Day)

A labyrinth is an ancient symbol of wholeness. The imagery of the circle and spiral combine into a meandering but purposeful journey. The Labyrinth represents a journey or path to our own center and back again out into the world. Labyrinths have long been used as meditation and prayer tools.

Themes of following God's way, spiritual journeys, and enjoying God's presence—all central to labyrinth experiences - are found throughout Scripture. One verse that can be used while walking the labyrinth is, *"You show me the path of life"*. *See Terry Diebold for more details.*
