Psalms

The Psalms are a collection of prayers set to music that are full of references to using music in worship. For example, Psalm 96:1-6 says, "Oh sing to the LORD a new song; sing to the LORD, all the earth!".

The New Testament identifies the types of music that are acceptable in worship, including psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs.

The people of Israel sang songs to the Lord after crossing the Red Sea, and singing was a part of their formal worship in the tabernacle and temple.

The Apostle Paul

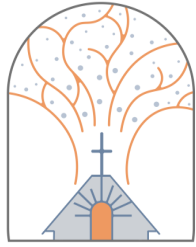
The Apostle Paul instructed the Colossians to sing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs to God.
